What is salvation?

Salvation is rescue from the punishment, power, and presence of sin. It is a restored relationship with God that comes from faith in the life, death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus Christ.

God saved you by his grace when you believed. And you can't take credit for this; it is a gift from God. Salvation is not a reward for the good things we have done, so none of us can boast about it.
