

72 Launch Memory Verses

- 1) **Colossians 1:18** – He is the head of the church. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that in everything He might be preeminent.
- 2) **2 Timothy 3:16** - All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness,¹⁷ so that the servant of God^a may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.
- 3) **Galatians 5:22-23** - But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness,²³ gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.
- 4) **Joshua 1:8** - Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful.
- 5) **Proverbs 22:1**- A good name is more desirable than great riches; to be esteemed is better than silver or gold.
- 6) **Ephesians 5:25** - Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her.
- 7) **Proverbs 16:9** -⁹ In their hearts man plan his course, but the LORD establishes their steps.
- 8) **Ephesians 2:8-9** - For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God—⁹ not by works, so that no one can boast.
- 9) **Proverbs 6:6-9** - Go to the ant, you sluggard; consider its ways and be wise!⁷ It has no commander, no overseer or ruler,⁸ yet it stores its provisions in summer and gathers its food at harvest.⁹ How long will you lie there, you sluggard? When will you get up from your sleep?
- 10) **Romans 6:4** - We were therefore buried with him through baptism into death in order that, just as Christ was raised from the dead through the glory of the Father, we too may live a new life.
- 11) **Ezekial 22:30** – I searched for a man among them who would build up the wall and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it, but I found no one.
- 12) **Philippians 2:3-4** – Do nothing out of selfish ambition or vain conceit. Rather in humility value others above yourself, not looking to your own interests, but to the interests of others.
- 13) **Ephesians 6:10-11** – Finally, be strong in the Lord and in His might power. Put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil’s schemes.
- 14) **Proverbs 21:31** – The horse is made ready for the day of battle, but victory rests with the Lord.
- 15) **James 1:19-20** – Know this, my beloved: let every person be quick to listen, slow to speak, and slow to anger; for the anger man does not produce the righteousness of God.
- 16) **1 Timothy 4:7** – Have nothing to do with godless myths and old wives’ tales; rather train yourself to be godly.
- 17) **Ephesians 1:16** – I do not cease to give thanks for you, remembering you in my prayers.
- 18) **Hebrews 10:24-25** - And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching.
- 19) **1 Corinthians 10:13** – No temptation has overtaken you that is not common to man. God is faithful, and he will not let you be tempted beyond your ability, but with the temptation he will also provide the way of escape, that you may be able to endure it.
- 20) **Psalms 127:4-5** – Like arrows in the hand of a warrior are the children of one’s youth. Blessed is the man who fills his quiver with them!
- 21) **Proverbs 26:15** – The sluggard buries his hand in a dish, but he is too lazy to bring it back to his mouth.
- 22) **Psalms 19:14**- May the words of my mouth and the meditations of my heart be pleasing to you O Lord, my rock and my redeemer.
- 23) **Matthew 4:18-20** – As Jesus was walking beside the Sea of Galilee, he saw 2 brothers, Simon called Peter and his brother Andrew. They were casting a net into the lake, for they were fishermen. “Come and follow me”, Jesus said, “and I will make you fishers of men.” At once they left their nets and followed him.

- 24) **Matthew 6:19-21** – Do not store up for yourselves treasures on earth, where moth and rust destroy, and where thieves break in and steal. Instead store up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where moth and rust do not destroy, and where thieves do not break in and steal. For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.
- 25) **Hebrews 4:12** - For the word of God is alive and active. Sharper than any double-edged sword, it penetrates even to dividing soul and spirit, joints and marrow; it judges the thoughts and attitudes of the heart.(Aug.14)
- 26) **1 Peter 3:8-9** - Finally, all of you, be like-minded, be sympathetic, love one another, be compassionate and humble. **9**Do not repay evil with evil or insult with insult. On the contrary, repay evil with blessing, because to this you were called so that you may inherit a blessing.
- 27) **Psalms 139:23-24** - Search me, God, and know my heart; test me and know my anxious thoughts. See if there is any offensive way in me, and lead me in the way everlasting.
- 28) **Proverbs 15:1** – A gentle answer turns away wrath, but a harsh words stir up anger.
- 29) **Proverbs 27:6** – Wounds from a friend can be trusted, but an enemy multiplies kisses.
- 30) **Psalms 127:1** – Unless the Lord builds the house, those who build it labor in vain. Unless the Lord watches over the city, the watchman stays awake in vain.
- 31) **Genesis 6:8** – But Noah found favor in the eyes of the Lord.
- 32) **Deuteronomy 5:29** – Oh that their hearts would be inclined to fear me and keep my commands always so that it might go well with them and their children.
- 33) **Ephesians 2:10** – For we are God’s workmanship created in His image to do good works that God has prepared in advance for us to do
- 34) **Proverbs 19:21** – Many are the plans in man’s heart, but it is the Lord’s purpose that prevails
- 35) **1 Timothy 4:8** - For physical training is of some value, but godliness has value for all things, holding promise for both the present life and the life to come.
- 36) **Matthew 4:19** - Come, follow me,” Jesus said, “and I will make you fishers of men.
- 37) **1 Corinthians 16:13** – Be on your guard; stand firm in the faith; be courageous; be strong.
- 38) **Hebrew 12:11** – No discipline seems pleasant at the time, but painful. Later on, however, it produces a harvest of righteousness and peace for those who have been trained by it.
- 39) **1 Samuel 16:7** - But the LORD said to Samuel, “Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The LORD does not look at the things people look at. People look at the outward appearance, but the LORD looks at the heart
- 40) **Joshua 14:8b** - I, however, followed the LORD my God wholeheartedly.
- 41) **Matthew 18:15-16** - If your brother sins against you, go and show him his fault, just between the two of you. If he listens to you, you have won your brother over. But if he will not listen, take one or two others along, so that every matter may be established by the testimony of two or three witnesses.
- 42) **Proverbs 27:17** – As iron sharpens iron so one man sharpens another

- **Genesis 1:1** – In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth.
- **Genesis 1:26** – Then God said, “Let **us** make man in our image, after our likeness. And let them have dominion over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the air and over the livestock and all the earth and every creeps on the earth.”
- **Genesis 1:28-30** – And God blessed them. And God said to them be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it, and have dominion over the fish and the birds and every other living thing that moves on the earth. And God said, Behold I have given you every plant yielding seed that is on the earth and every tree with seed in its fruit. You shall have them for your food. And to every beast, bird, and everything that creeps on the earth, that has the breath of life, I have given every green plant for food.
- **Genesis 2:15-17** – The Lord took man and put him in the garden of Eden to work it and to keep it. And the Lord commanded the man saying “you may eat of every tree of the garden, but of the tree of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the days you eat you shall surely die.”
- **Genesis 2:24** – Therefore a man shall leave his father and mother and hold fast to his wife and they shall become one flesh.
