Prayer Guidelines

1. Regarding Tongues – We all come from different backgrounds. If speaking in tongues is part of your regular practice, please refrain from doing so during this time. We seek to avoid confusion and edify one another as instructed in 1 Corinthians 14:1-12.
2. Regarding Distractions – Often when we pray we can easily be distracted by the sounds and activities around us, but most of us are distracted by our own thoughts. Instead of trying to block distractions out, use them as a method to draw near to Jesus.
 - Trying to Block:* Telling yourself, “Don’t worry about that problem right now” or “I can’t concentrate because of that person talking.”
 - Method of Drawing Near:* “Jesus, you know I’m worried about this problem, I offer it to you and give you this time,” or “Jesus, I pray for that person speaking...”
3. Regarding Topics – Please try and keep the topic of your prayer to things close to our body. We know God cares about everything and everyone, but this time is specifically devoted to praying for our local body. Here is a list of ministries going on during this time:
